

HB 1034 -- TENTH AMENDMENT PRESERVATION ACT

SPONSOR: Griesheimer

This bill establishes the "Tenth Amendment Preservation Act", which affirms the Tenth Amendment of the Constitution of the United States by declaring that acts of all types by the federal government that exceed its enumerated powers and involve matters reserved to the states are rejected by this state and shall not be enforced. Missouri courts and law enforcement agencies will protect all powers and rights reserved to the state or to individuals.

The bill contains a severability clause.
