

HB 1048 -- SALES TAX

SPONSOR: Hurlbert

This bill authorizes the governing body of any city of the fourth classification with more than 8,000 but fewer than 9,000 inhabitants and located partially in any county of the first classification with more than 200,000 but fewer than 260,000 inhabitants and partially in any county of the first classification with more than 83,000 but fewer than 92,000 inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more than 4,500 but fewer than 5,000 inhabitants as the county seat to levy a 1/2% sales tax for public safety upon voter approval.

Currently, the provisions of this bill apply to the City of Smithville.

This bill is similar to HB 1726 (2020).
