HB 1208 -- ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAM CREDITS

SPONSOR: Brown (16)

This bill requires public institutions of higher learning to adopt and implement policies, as outlined in the bill, that will give undergraduate course credit to entering freshman students for each advanced placement (AP) examination upon which such student achieves a score of three or higher. The Coordinating Board for Higher Education will consult with the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education to identify correlations between subject matter and content in courses and examinations in the AP program, and shall make that information public on the Board's website.

This bill is the same as HB 192 (2021) and HB 1508 (2020)
