HB 1301 -- ELECTIONS

SPONSOR: Riggs

This bill requires that the laws in effect on election day provide the sole governing procedures for vote counting and the administration of elections. Modifications by any method after the day of the election shall not be allowed except that a statute may be held unconstitutional under the Constitution of the United States.

The General Assembly shall retain authority to name presidential electors in cases of fraud or a violation of the bill and may act by joint resolution without the signature of the Governor to meet and vote upon presidential electors to ensure their selection in a timely manner.
