

HB 1328 -- 21ST CENTURY MISSOURI POWER GRID TASK FORCE

SPONSOR: Riggs

This bill establishes the "21st-Century Missouri Power Grid Task Force". The membership of the Task Force includes: three members of the House of Representatives with two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one appointed by the Minority Leader, three members of the Senate with two appointed by the President Pro Tem of the Senate and one appointed by the Minority Leader, and 11 representing various government agencies and interested parties.

The mission of the Task Force is to evaluate the current capabilities of the existing power grid and make recommendations for modernizing the state's power grid. The Task Force will make recommendations for legislation as well as submit a report outlining a summary of Task Force activities to the General Assembly before August 28, 2022. The Task Force will suspend operations on January 1, 2023 and reconvene January 1, 2024 to provide updates and review recommendations to be presented by August 28, 2024.
