

HB 1330 -- RESTRAINING PREGNANT PRISONERS

SPONSOR: Doll

This bill specifies that a county or city jail must not restrain a pregnant prisoner in her third trimester or during labor and delivery or 48 hours postpartum. The bill also specifies procedures county and city jails must follow when they are restraining pregnant offenders in their third trimester of pregnancy or offenders within 48 hours postpartum.
