HB 1367 -- MEMORIAL BRIDGE

SPONSOR: Gregory (96)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 13 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill designates the bridge on Interstate 64 crossing over Sarah Street in the City of St. Louis as the "Police Surgeon James F Cooper MD Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation will erect and maintain the signs, with the costs paid by private donations.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is a fitting tribute to Police Surgeon James F Cooper MD.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Gregory; Missouri Fraternal Order of Police; St. Louis Police Officers Association; Rick Trevor; and Gary Knight.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that that this is unfair to all other members of our armed forces that sacrificed their life for our freedom while on official duty.
