This resolution designates April 8, 2021, as "Holocaust Remembrance Day" in Missouri.

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the introduced version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill is important to remember Holocaust victims in order to understand and appreciate their lives and the communities they built.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Dogan; Arnie Dienoff; and the Jewish Federation of St. Louis.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
