

HCS SCS SB 119 -- TELECOMMUNICATION PRACTICES

SPONSOR: Burlison (Trent)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on General Laws by a vote of 9 to 3. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 9 to 0.

The following is a summary of the House Committee Substitute for SB 119.

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the introduced version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill creates the same penalty provisions as spam. These issues effect everyone and this bill will protect the general public, especially the most vulnerable of Missouri citizens.

Testifying for the bill were Senator Burlison; Arnie Dienoff; and Kendall Martinez-Wright.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
