

HCS SS SB 283 -- REGULATED INDUSTRIES

SPONSOR: Hoskins (Wallingford)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on General Laws by a vote of 8 to 4. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 11 to 0.

The following is a summary of the House Committee Substitute for SB 283.

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the introduced version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill brings together many provisions that are supported by the citizens and institutions as it will be beneficial for all.

Testifying for the bill were Senator Hoskins; Daron Jacobs; Missouri Licensed Beverage Retailers Association; National Restaurant Association; Jase Bennett and Todd Randall, Randall's Wine And Spirits; and the Missouri Restaurant Association.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that this bill will cause trouble for retailers. The bill also offers no oversight on how many products can be delivered at a time.

Testifying against the bill were Arnie Dienoff; Missouri Beer Wholesalers Association; Major Brands; and Southern Glazer's Wine and Spirits.
