

HCS SB 330 -- LICENSED PROFESSIONALS

SPONSOR: Burlison (Shields)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on Professional Registration and Licensing by a vote of 13 to 1. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules-Legislative Oversight by a vote of 11 to 0.
