It is my understanding that the State of Missouri has no long-term plans for Rieger Armory. When it was constructed in the 1930's, and for many decades thereafter, one of the primary functions of the Armory was as a community center for Kirksville. Many events were held there, from big band performances to live country music shows on KIRX radio. Unfortunately, the community's ability to use the Armory largely ended years ago. The conveyance of the Armory to local					

government would again ensure the community's ability to use the building to improve our community. This conveyance to local government would also ensure the Armory is maintained in perpetuity. This is especially important given the important place the Armory holds in our local history. Local government is committed to historic preservation, and seeks to not only breathe new life into the facility, but ensure it is available for the community's use for years to come. This is preservation with a purpose, and that process begins with this bill. Thank you for your consideration and for your service to our state.

The school district has no need for the building, and the City of Kirksville does not want to see such a large and important building fall into disrepair and become an unusable eyesore. An exchange has been proposed that would benefit the whole community. In return for the school district giving the armory to the city for use as a community center, the city will provide infrastructure on undeveloped land that the vocational-technical students can use to continue building homes. Too often we have seen historic buildings like this one become shells of their former selves and ultimately be torn down at taxpayer expense. With your support of HB 1032, you can help to ensure this building stands for decades to come, that seniors and children have a place to hold activities, and that vo-tech students continue to develop their skills.
