Mr. Chairman and Committee Members, Thank you for taking the time to consider a possible correction to the current actions of the State Department of Labor in regard to the recoupment of unemployment benefits paid out last year during the pandemic. I realize that the state's system was overwhelmed, and the it's possible that the state overpaid those who legitimately applied. I also realize that in any system relying on humans, there is great possibility for error. I believe the BIGGEST error being made is by the Department of Labor in their stubborn and ill-informed stance demanding repayment of benefits from Missouri citizens who did not intend to defraud anyone, but merely applied for and were granted unemployment benefits. If there have been errors made they have all be made by				

for and were granted unemployment benefits. If there have been errors made, they have all be made by the State of Missouri, not our fellow citizens who were forced out of work in the midst of COVID-19. I am the CFO for the City of St. Charles School District. We laid off bus drivers, para professionals, secretaries, custodians, and other classified staff during the height of school and business closures last Spring. These people were not on a summer break, they were furloughed due to the pandemic. I submit this testimony to you for your consideration on behalf on my fellow employees. I was fortunate enough to not be negatively financially impacted, however, when I see who among our employees was impacted, they are our lowest paid and most vulnerable. Please do whatever is necessary to stop the efforts to recoup unemployment benefits paid out to these people months after they actually received the payments. Again, to sum up the situation; many of our fellow citizens made legitimate application for unemployement benefits. That the State of Missouri was not able to correct accept, process, and pay these applications according to their rules, should not now be held against those who are among our most vulnerable citizens. Thank you for your public service to our state.
