HB1320 allows for restitution to landowners for damages from someone that KNOWINGLY or INTENTIONALLY releases hogs to live in a feral state. It also protects a landowners private property rights by allowing a landowner or landowners agent to use night vision, thermal imaging or infrared. Most importantly, it protects "Right to Farm" here in Missouri by not being breed discriminatory. Feral is not a breed of hog but merely a state of confinement. This bill provides stiff penalties for those individuals releasing and/or transporting these animals to further their sport of hog hunting including guided hunts for payment.
