Committee Members:For reasons listed below, the Missouri State Council of Fire Fighters are respectfully submitting testimony in opposition to HB363. The job of Fire Fighter is inherently dangerous. Most fire fighters understand this when they make the commitment to serve their community. However, there are many risks that are unknown or unseen and some that are unavoidable; cancer being the largest. Exposure to the cancer-causing byproducts/chemicals of combustion is unavoidable, and our members are contracting cancer at rates that far exceed the rest of the population. When we enter a structure fire, we are aware of the risk; dangers of collapse, smoke and flames, flashover, etc. Cancer cannot be seen, our gear doesn't protect against it, and we were not aware of these hidden risks when we became fire fighters. Once the fire is out and the people are safe, Fire Fighters conduct salvage and overhaul operations to ensure the fire hasn't extended into the walls or ceilings, and to confirm the cause of the fire. The products of combustion (Arsenic, Benzene, CO. Formaldehyde, Glutaraldehyde, Hydrogen Cyanide, Hydrogen Chloride, Mercury, Nitrogen Dioxide) continue to off-gas and the products of construction (Asbestos) remain a real hazard in these operations. These toxic chemicals also have a devastating effect on Fire Fighter's respiratory, cardiac, and neurological systems. Without legal protections against Asbestos causing cancer in the State of Missouri, our members deserve access to every legal remedy available to make themselves whole from these invisible hazards of the job.
