Testimony from the Missouri Prairie Foundation, a 501(c)(3), nonprofit organization in support of HB 369 - PRESCRIBED BURNING ACT• HB 369 seeks to formally define the liability standards that landowners must meet when using prescribed fire on their property. • Missouri is one of only five states that does not have a prescribed burning statute. Defining liability in prescribed fire legislation is not removing liability. Defining liability will enable insurance companies to offer policies providing protection to prescribed fire practitioners.• Many managers of private lands are exposed to unnecessary risk every time they use prescribed fire because there is currently no legislation in place that legally defines their liability. While some landowners conduct their own prescribed burns, others must depend on professionals to safely complete prescribed burns. However, insurance for contractors is often either unattainable or uneconomical because liability for prescribed fire is not defined.• There are many benefits of carefully planned prescribed fire to wild landscapes, wildlife habitat, habitat management businesses, and agricultural landowners.
