Dear Representative Ruth and members of the House Committee on Transportation: On behalf of the Christian County Business Development Corporation, please accept this letter of support for Senate Bill 262. A strong transportation system is vital for a thriving economy and is especially crucial in Christian County, as 75-80% of our working population commutes during the day. Missouri has a strong geographic advantage as a transportation hub, which makes safe and efficient infrastructure a crucial element in our growth and development. Unfortunately, funding to maintain our state's roads and bridges has not kept pace with the need. Missouri has the 7th largest system in the nation but ranks 45th nationally in revenue per mile, funded with one of the lowest fuel taxes in the country. Christian County, MO is primed for growth in the distribution and warehousing sectors, especially in light of rapidly rising e-commerce volume. However, our ability to attract and retain existing business investment in these areas is dependent on the safety and maintenance of our state transportation infrastructure. Our two largest anchor municipalities, Nixa and Ozark, have major highways running through town. These, along with our roads and bridges, are vital to both our workforce and our economy. This proposal will ensure additional, long-term funding is dedicated to transportation. The investment will help guarantee that our transportation infrastructure is a well-maintained asset, not a liability. Transportation investment is key to Missouri's economic success. As we continue to recover from the coronavirus pandemic, investing in the state's infrastructure will be key to job creation and growth, the ability of our workforce to succeed, and our ability to leverage investment. We believe this approach to infrastructure is the long-term funding mechanism this state needs, and we encourage your support of Senate Bill 262. EDC of Kansas City, MO Supports SB 262 After reviewing the bill, the Economic Development Corporation (EDC) of Kansas City, MO supports SB 262. We proudly join Missourians for Transportation Investment (MFTI) and several other partners in doing so. We believe passage for this legislation is importation for the following reasons: • While we understand hesitancy to raise any tax, the reality is that inaction contributes to \$825 million of additional deferred maintenance each year in the state of Missouri. It is simply unacceptable to hand this burden to a future generation. • Missouri's transportation network is one of the biggest in the nation while our fuel tax is one of the lowest. While the cost to build and maintain infrastructure has risen significantly, our fuel tax has not budged in years which means we have less purchasing power each and every year. • Anecdotaly, we continue to hear from business after business that the quality of infrastructure is a critical factor in decision making to move to Missouri, expand their current operations in Missouri, or sometimes stay in the state altogether. • Site selectors across the nation constantly rank transportation & infrastructure as a critical factor. Missouri is viewed unfavorably in this regard, which hurts our economic competitiveness. Of note, EDCKC convenes a 26-member legislative committee to create the KC Consensus Agenda on Economic Development. This committee is comprised of diverse economic developer stakeholder organizations across Kansas City. The goal of the agenda is to represent Kansas City's economic development priorities. One particular area of interest for the committee was to support transportation investment, and we believe that SB 262 supports that aim.

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Thank you for your work relating to transportation in the State of Missouri. The Ozarks Transportation Organization, the Springfield Area Metropolitan Planning Organization, Board of Directors strongly supports additional funding for transportation. The Springfield area has a long list of unfunded transportation needs on both the MoDOT system and the locally owned county and municipal systems. There is no perfect solution to the funding of Missouri's roads. However, investment is needed now and the proposed moderate fuel tax increase will provide revenue now. In our region we have identified over \$500 million in needed investments through 2040. When we include transit, this need is over \$600 million. We have a data-driven prioritization process to direct the limited funding available to the most needed projects. Among these unfunded needed projects are the • Six-laning of I-44, • Improvements to Highway 13/Kansas Expressway in the City of Springfield, • US60 upgrade to freeway- east of Springfield • And Others Once fully implemented, the tax would generate approximately \$23 million annually for MoDOT projects in the Springfield area. For reference, the expansion of I-44 will cost \$68 million between US65 and US360. This new revenue could address I-44 within the first five years of implementation. In addition, to the State of Missouri owned roadway needs, the revenue shared with cities and counties would fund the rebuilding of aging bridges and maintenance of pavements. The population growth of our region coupled with the job growth in the urban core has left revenue short of funding the needed maintenance. Additional revenue would allow our communities and our region to support aging infrastructure and accommodate ongoing growth. Thank you for giving me the opportunity to explain the positive outcomes of the potential fuel tax increase for transportation projects in the Springfield area.
