The Sierra Club Missouri Chapter opposes SCR 16. This Keystone XL pipeline is part of an effort by the oil industry to export millions of barrels per day of tar sands from Alberta through the United States to international markets. Extracting tar sands is one of the most destructive projects on earth. Reliance on tar sands oil hinders our ability to avoid climate disaster. The US faces a clear choice: promote the oil industry's interests by green-lighting the most carbon-intensive, destructive oil on the planet, or demonstrate a bold commitment to addressing climate disruption and promoting clean energy solutions by saying no to Keystone XL. President Joe Biden made the right choice. Claims of job creation for the project have been greatly overblown as if the project was completed there would only be an estimated 35 permanent full time jobs associated with the pipeline. Investments in renewable energy and energy efficiency can and do produce many more good paying, permanent jobs than the Keystone XL pipeline could ever produce. Claims about the pipeline being needed for domestic energy security are also inaccurate. If it were built, the main purpose of the Keystone XL pipeline would be to facilitate the shipment of dirty tar sands based petroleum from one foreign country (Canada) to multiple overseas foreign countries via ports in the Gulf of Mexico. The pipeline proposal threatens the water, land and health of thousands of Americans if there were a spill while the oil flowed from one foreign country to other foreign countries. We don't need this - we should support our President for making the correct choice on this issue.
