SS#3 SB 1 - MO HEALTHNET

SPONSOR: Hegeman

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Budget by a vote of 27 to 2. Voted "Do Pass" by the Committee on Rules-Legislative Oversight by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill extends the sunsets from September 30, 2021, to September 30, 2024, for the Ground Ambulance, Nursing Facility, Medicaid Managed Care Organization, Hospital, Pharmacy, and Intermediate Care Facility for the Intellectually Disabled Federal Reimbursement Allowances.

Additionally, the bill excludes from MO HealthNet coverage of family planning services any abortifacient drug or device used to induce an abortion.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the FRA is needed to fund hospitals, ambulances, nursing homes and pharmacies. Without the FRA funding, the majority of nursing homes and pharmacies would have to close.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say they don't want tax dollars going toward abortions.
