2 Senate Bill No. 834, Page 18, Section 559.115, Line 77, by inserting after all of said section and line  
3 the following:

5 "570.212. 1. As used in this section, "mail" means a letter, postal card, package, bag, or  
6 other sealed article that:

7 (1) Is delivered by a common carrier or delivery service and not yet received by the  
8 addressee; or

9 (2) Has been left to be collected for delivery by a common carrier or delivery service.

10 2. A person commits the offense of mail theft if the person purposefully appropriates mail  
11 from another person's mailbox or premises without consent of the addressee and with intent to  
12 deprive such addressee of the mail.

13 3. The offense of mail theft is a class A misdemeanor for a first offense and a class E felony  
14 for any second or subsequent offense."; and

16 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
17 accordingly.
