election official's family, including stalking p	
(5) Disseminates through any means,	including by posting on the internet, the personal
nformation of an election official or any men	mber of an election official's family. For purposes of
his section, "personal information" includes	a Social Security number, federal tax identification
_	ers, credit card numbers, marital status, or identity of a
child under eighteen years of age.	
2. For the purposes of this section, the	e term "election official" includes election judges,
challengers, watchers, and other volunteers o	r employees of an election authority. The offense of
campering with an election official shall be a	class D felony. If a violation of this section results in
death or bodily injury to an election official of	or a member of the official's family, the offense shall be
a class B felony."; and
