1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute No. 2 for Senate Committee Substitute
2 for Senate Bill No. 745, Page 21, Section 144.030, Line 411, by inserting after all of the said section
3 and line the following:

5 "260.243. 1. For facilities permitted before August 28, 2022, the department of natural
6 resources shall not issue a permit to an applicant for a commercial solid waste processing facility
7 designed to incinerate solid waste in any county unless such facility meets the conditions established
8 in this section. For the purposes of this section, a commercial solid waste processing facility is a
9 facility designed to incinerate waste which accepts solid waste for a fee regardless of where such
10 waste is generated. Any commercial solid waste processing facility which incinerates solid waste
11 shall be located so as to provide a health and safety buffer zone to protect citizens living or working
12 nearby. The size of the buffer zone shall be determined by the department but shall extend at least
13 fifty feet from a facility located in a nonresidential area in a city not within a county or at least three
14 hundred feet from a facility located elsewhere. The department shall consider the proximity of
15 schools, businesses and houses, the prevailing winds and other factors which it deems relevant when
16 establishing the buffer zone. Any facility located within a city not within a county shall be required
17 to strictly adhere to the terms, conditions and provisions of its permit.

18 2. (1) For any facility permitted on or after August 28, 2022, the department of natural
19 resources shall not issue a permit to an applicant for a transfer station in any county with a charter
20 form of government unless such transfer station meets the conditions established in this subsection.
21 Any transfer station shall provide a buffer zone determined by the department that shall extend at
22 least one thousand feet from a transfer station located in a residential area. The department shall
23 consider the proximity of schools, businesses, and houses when establishing the buffer zone.

24 (2) This subsection shall not apply to any permit renewal, modifications, or amendments to
25 any transfer station originally permitted as provided in subsection 1 of this section."; and

27 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
28 accordingly.
