1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 820, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by
2 inserting after all of said section and line:

4 "217.451. 1. No correctional center or other party shall charge an offender in a correctional
5 center a total amount for a domestic phone call, including fees and any per-minute rate, that exceeds
6 the equivalent of twelve cents per minute.

7 2. Beginning January 1, 2026, and every three years thereafter, the cents-per-minute limit
8 under subsection 1 of this section shall be adjusted for inflation using the Consumer Price Index for
9 All Urban Consumers, or its successor index, as such index is defined and officially reported by the
10 United States Department of Labor, or its successor agency. Any inflation adjustment shall be
11 rounded down to the nearest cent.

12 221.108. 1. No jail or other party shall charge an inmate in a jail a total amount for a
13 domestic phone call, including fees and any per-minute rate, that exceeds the equivalent of:

14 (1) Fourteen cents per minute for any jail with an average daily population of one thousand
15 or more inmates; or

16 (2) Twenty-one cents per minute for any jail with an average daily population of fewer than
17 one thousand inmates.

18 2. Beginning January 1, 2026, and every three years thereafter, the cents-per-minute limits
19 under subsection 1 of this section shall be adjusted for inflation using the Consumer Price Index for
20 All Urban Consumers, or its successor index, as such index is defined and officially reported by the
21 United States Department of Labor, or its successor agency. Any inflation adjustment shall be
22 rounded down to the nearest cent."; and
