1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill Nos. 681 & 662, Page 54, Section 167.645, Line 208, by inserting after all of the same  
3 section and line the following:

5 "167.177 1. Interscholastic or intramural athletic teams that are sponsored by a public  
6 school shall be expressly designated as one of the following based on biological sex:

7 (1) "Males", "men", or "boys";

8 (2) "Females", "women", or "girls"; or

9 (3) "Coed" or "mixed".

10 2. Athletic teams or sports designated for "females", "women", or "girls" shall not be open  
11 to students of the male sex. Students of the female sex who previously participated in athletic teams  
12 or sports designated for "females", "women", or "girls" and who have begun gender or sex  
13 transitioning shall not participate in athletic teams or sports designated for "females", "women", or  
14 "girls" but may participate in athletic teams or sports designated "coed" or "mixed". Students of the  
15 female sex may participate in athletic teams or sports designated for "males", "men", or "boys" if the  
16 public school does not offer a comparable athletic team or sport designated for "females", "women",  
17 or "girls".

18 3. The general assembly may enact laws to implement this section including, without  
19 limitation, laws concerning:

20 (1) Protections for public schools from complaints, investigations, or other adverse actions  
21 for maintaining separate interscholastic or intramural athletic teams or sports for students of the  
22 male and female sex; and

23 (2) Causes of action for injunctive relief, damages, and any other relief available under law  
24 for:

25 (a) A student who is deprived of an athletic opportunity or who suffers direct or indirect  
26 harm resulting from a violation of this section;

27 (b) A student who is subject to retaliation or other adverse action by a public school as a  
28 result of reporting a violation of this section; or

29 (c) A public school that suffers any direct or indirect harm as a result of a violation of this  
30 section."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
33 accordingly.
