1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill Nos. 681 & 662, Page 54, Section 167.645, Line 208, by inserting after all of the said  
3 section and line the following:

5 “167.780. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Save Women's Sports Act".  
6 The provisions of this section shall apply to sports or athletic competitions, tournaments, and games  
7 intended for individuals under the age of nineteen.

8 2. Every sponsor, organizing entity for sports for students in kindergarten through grade  
9 twelve, or facilitator of children or youth sports competitions shall designate each team,  
10 competition, tournament, and game as designated for exclusively males, females, or intramural.

11 3. No team, competition, tournament, or game designated for females, women, or girls shall  
12 be open to participation by males, men, or boys.

13 4. No team, competition, tournament, or game designated for males, men, or boys shall be  
14 open to participation by females, women, or girls.

15 5. The gender of participants in children or youth games shall be determined by the gender  
16 as assigned to the participant at birth.

17 6. Any participant in children or youth sports or athletic team, competition, tournament, or  
18 game who is disadvantaged in any way by a violation of this section may recover damages and  
19 equitable relief as a result of another's violation of this section.

20 7. No public school, private middle school, or private high school that has biological males  
21 as assigned at birth playing women's sports shall be eligible for any moneys appropriated by the  
22 general assembly.”; and

24 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
25 accordingly.
