1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill Nos. 681 & 662, Page 40, Section 163.016, Line 28, by inserting after all of said section
3 and line the following:

5 "163.063. 1. For the purpose of determining state and local funding for a child's education,
6 if the child resides in a residential treatment facility or other facility and is unable to attend in the
7 public school district where the child resides, either because the child may be a safety risk or the
8 child has behavioral conditions that support the need to educate the child on such facility's site or
9 campus and the school district uses the residential care facility to provide any portion of the child's
10 education, the school district shall pass through to such facility at least eighty percent of any state or
11 local moneys paid to the district on a per-pupil basis for such child in addition to any other moneys
12 available to the school district through the department of elementary and secondary education for
13 such child.

14 2. If the school district provides a teacher or other educational resources to such residential
15 treatment facility or other facility, the district may use moneys provided under subsection 1 of this
16 section to offset the cost of such teacher or other educational resources that are directly attributable
17 to such child in state custody at such facility's site or campus. Such facility shall be afforded
18 reasonable costs associated with such child's education up to the average per-pupil cost. No such
19 facility shall be required to offset the costs to the child's school district for the education of such
20 child as long as such costs of education do not exceed the average per-pupil spending on an annual
21 basis within the school district.

22 3. The school district shall provide an annual accounting to the residential treatment facility
23 or other facility and shall either support or approve the facility's education plan for such child or
24 provide for the child's education on such facility's site or campus.

25 4. If a child receives educational services from a residential care facility, it shall be the
26 responsibility of the school district in which the child resides to provide for the education of the
27 child and ensure the child is receiving education services that are substantially similar to the
28 curriculum and standards of the school district.

29 5. The provisions of this section shall not apply to school boards authorized under sections
30 162.670 to 162.999."; and
