"167.780. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Save Women's Sports Act".
2. No athletic team or sport designated for biological females shall be open to students that
are biological males.
3. No governmental entity, licensing or accrediting organization, or athletic association or
organization shall entertain a complaint, open an investigation, or take any other adverse action
gainst a school or institution for maintaining separate interscholastic or intramural athletic teams or
sports for students that are biological females.
4. No public school or a private middle school or high school, or a public or private
nstitution of postsecondary education, that has biological males playing biological females' sports
shall be eligible for any moneys appropriated by the general assembly.
5. For the purposes of this section, the following terms shall mean:
(1) "Biological females", persons with the biological indicators of a female in the context of
eproductive potential or capacity, such as the absence of a Y chromosome, naturally occurring sex
normones, gonads, and nonambiguous internal and external genitalia present at birth, without regard
o an individual's psychological, chosen, or subjective experience of gender;
(2) "Biological males", persons with the biological indicators of a male in the context of
eproductive potential or capacity, such as the presence of a Y chromosome, naturally occurring sex
normones, gonads, and nonambiguous external genitalia present at birth, without regard to an
ndividual's psychological, chosen, or subjective of gender."; and
Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
