1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 652, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and  
2 line the following:

4 "144.016. 1. Beginning October 1, 2022, the tax levied and imposed under chapter 144 on  
5 all retail sales of feminine hygiene products and diapers shall be levied at a rate not exceeding the  
6 rate of sales tax levied on the retail sale of food.

7 2. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

8 (1) "Diapers", absorbent garments worn by infants or toddlers who are not toilet-trained or  
9 by individuals who are incapable of controlling their bladder or bowel movements;

10 (2) "Feminine hygiene products", tampons, pads, liners, and cups;

11 (3) "Food", the same meaning as defined under section 144.014."; and

13 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
14 accordingly.
