1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 724, Page 1, Section A, Line 9, by inserting after all of said section and line the  
3 following:

5 "34.605. 1. No public or private entity receiving public funds shall enter into a contract  
6 with Russia, Russian entities, or any other country adversely occupying or attacking a North  
7 Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) member, Ukraine, Finland, Sweden, or Georgia; except that,  
8 nothing in this section shall apply to transactions authorized under Ukraine General License Number  
9 18 issued on February 21, 2022, by the Office of Foreign Assets Control of the United States  
10 Department of the Treasury.

11 2. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

12 (1) "Private entity", any for-profit or not-for-profit organization, association, corporation,  
13 partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability  
14 company, sole proprietorship, or other entity or business association, including all wholly owned  
15 subsidiaries, majority-owned subsidiaries, parent companies, or affiliates of those entities or  
16 business associations that receives any public funding;

17 (2) "Public entity", the state of Missouri, or any political subdivision thereof, including all  
18 boards, commissions, agencies, institutions, authorities, and bodies politic and corporate of the state,  
19 created by or in accordance with state law or regulations;

20 (3) "Russia" or "Russian entity", the country of Russia or any for-profit or not-for-profit  
21 organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited  
22 liability partnership, limited liability company, sole proprietorship, or other entity or business  
23 association, including all wholly owned subsidiaries, majority-owned subsidiaries, parent  
24 companies, or affiliates of those entities or business associations organized under the laws of Russia.

25 3. Any contract that fails to comply with the provisions of this section shall be void against  
26 public policy.

27 4. The commissioner of administration or his or her designee may promulgate regulations to  
28 implement the provisions of this section so long as they are consistent with this section and do not  
29 create any exceptions. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that  
30 is created under the authority of this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is

1 subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and  
2 chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to  
3 chapter 536, to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently  
4 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after  
5 August 28, 2022, shall be invalid and void."; and

7 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
8 accordingly.
