AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2140, Page 47, Section 1, Line 48, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:
"Section 2. A person commits the offense of tampering with an election official if, with the
purpose to harass, intimidate, or influence such official in the performance of such official's official
duties, such person disseminates through any means, including by posting on the internet, the
official's family's personal information. For purposes of this section, "personal information
includes a home address, Social Security number, federal tax identification number, checking of
savings account numbers, marital status, and identity of a child under eighteen years of age. For the
purposes of this section, the term "election official" includes election judges, challengers, watcher
and other volunteers or employees of an election authority. The offense of tampering with a
election official shall be a class D felony. If a violation of this section results in death or bodil
injury to an election official or a member of the official's family, the offense shall be a class
<u>felony.</u> "; and
Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
