1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2140, Pages 8 and 9, Section 115.157,  
2 Lines 39 - 61, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "4. Except as provided in subsection 6 of this section, upon a request by a candidate, a duly  
5 authorized representative of a campaign committee, or a political party committee, the secretary of  
6 state shall furnish, for a fee determined by the secretary of state and in compliance with section  
7 610.026, media in an electronic format or, if so requested, in a printed format, showing the names,  
8 addresses, and voter identification numbers of voters within the jurisdiction of a specific election  
9 authority who applied for an absentee ballot under section 115.279 for any specific election  
10 involving a ballot measure or an office for which the declaration of candidacy is required to be filed  
11 with the secretary of state pursuant to section 115.353, including primary elections, by township,  
12 ward, or precinct. Nothing in this section shall require such voter information to be released to the  
13 public over the internet. For purposes of this section, the terms "candidate", "campaign committee",  
14 and "political party committee" shall have the same meaning given to such terms in section 130.011.

15 5. The amount of fees charged for information provided in this section shall be established  
16 pursuant to chapter 610. All revenues collected by the secretary of state pursuant to this section  
17 shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the secretary of state's technology trust fund  
18 account established pursuant to section 28.160. In even-numbered years, each election authority  
19 shall, upon request, supply the voter registration list for its jurisdiction to all candidates and party  
20 committees for a charge established pursuant to chapter 610. Except as provided in subsection 6 of  
21 this section, all election authorities shall make the information described in this section available  
22 pursuant to chapter 610. Any election authority who fails to comply with the requirements of this  
23 section shall be subject to the provisions of chapter 610.

24 6. Any person working as an undercover officer of a local, state or federal law"; and
