HCS SS SB 690 -- HEALTH CARE

SPONSOR: Thompson Rehder (Christofanelli)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on Emerging Issues by a vote of 8 to 2. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 8 to 3.

The following is a summary of the House Committee Substitute for SB 690.

This House Committee Substitute incorporates several bills and provisions. Please see the Summary Sheet for a detailed list of the additional bills and provisions added to the House Committee Substitute version of the Senate bill.

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the Senate Perfected version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that Missouri is at high risk for drug overdose, with 13 counties currently on a federal watch list for overdoses. Syringe access and service programs can save lives, with up to four times greater outcomes for recovery. These programs present a fuller approach towards treating addiction. These programs also prevent the spread of diseases and help mitigate risks of transmission. The current lack of syringe access is a large gap in the state's opioid response. Syringe access and service programs are a cost-effective and humane measure, with broad support from police officers and first responders.
