

HCS SS SCS SB 724 -- POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS

SPONSOR: Hegeman (Cupps)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Special Committee on Public Policy by a vote of 5 to 0 with 1 voting present. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules-Administrative Oversight by a vote of 9 to 3.

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the Senate Perfected version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill protects small political subdivisions while also providing checks and balances to ensure proper reporting by these political subdivisions

Testifying for the bill were Senator Hegeman; Missouri Municipal League; and Missouri Press Association. Additional written testimony was submitted in support of the bill.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that certain provisions of the bill only target St. Charles County school districts. The state should not be adversely affecting the bond process for a small group of schools.

Testifying against the bill was Kara Elms. Additional written testimony was submitted in opposition to the bill.
