

SJR 46 -- COUNTY ASSESSORS

SPONSOR: Cierpiot (Baker)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Downsizing State Government by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 8 to 0 with 2 voting Present.

If approved by the voters, this Constitutional amendment requires that all county assessors be elected. Currently, assessors of all charter counties except for Jackson County are required to be elected officers.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the assessor of Jackson county should have to be elected.

Testifying for the bill were Senator Cierpiot; and Arnie C. Dienoff.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
