This is solely do to the differing physical characteristics, attributes, and abilities based on those XX/XY chromosomes, not any other factor. Such differences could easily cause great harm to those with XX.Therefore, XY and XX individuals deserve their own leagues in which to compete against their own kind, not as a method to exclude those that feel they are XY or those that feel that they are XXThat an XY swimmer could go from a ranking of 146 against XY swimmers to a ranking of Number 1 against XX swimmers is proof positive that athletes should not be able to change their outcome by claiming a right to compete outside their groups' abilities. It's no different than and every bit as silly as a 20yo athlete claiming they are 'trans-age' and competing against 10yo athletes.

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My brother, a Catholic theologian and professor, has helped me better understand the bedrock principles that underlie Catholic Social Teaching. As Rep. Burger's public House Biography states his commitment to his own Catholic faith (which I respect but do not share), perhaps he and the rest of you will consider how this bill would undermine those teachings.1) Life and Dignity of the Human Person attacking transgender athletes for being transgender suggests a lack of dignity for their individual personhood, and is a key factor in elevated suicide rates in this group of God's beloved children.2) Call to Family, Community, and Participation - The USSCCB states, "We believe people have a right and a duty to participate in society, seeking together the common good and well-being of all, especially the poor and vulnerable." Few persons are more vulnerable than transgender individuals, perpetuated by these baseless attacks against them by the government who should work for their full acceptance in our society.3) Rights and Responsibilities - "The Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and responsibilities are met." If trans rights are human rights (and they are, because transgender persons are human), then their rights must be protected, and we have a responsibility to do so.4) Option for the Poor and Vulnerable - Two topics where my Catholic siblings far outpace us Protestants is in care for the economically poor and vulnerable, and in knowing that a faithful understanding of poverty requires a definition that encompasses more than balance statements and material wealth. There are no frontiers or barriers, political or social, behind which we can hide, still less is there room for the globalization of indifference." Pope Francis again, in Laudato Si. Our transgender siblings are our family, and you would target them for political gain. There is no solidarity there.7) Care for God's Creation - "Let us not leave in our wake a swath of destruction and death which will affect our own lives and those of future generations." Pope Francis, Evangelii GuadiumGod calls us to unity and to justice and to solidarity and to keep all these in mind when we perform our work. Your work is to legislate. The only faithful path forward is to #LetThemPlay.

Every individual is entitled to kavod habriyot by having been made b'tzelem elohim, in God's image. As an organization grounded in Jewish values, we have an ethical and moral responsibility to fight for a society that ensures the humanity, dignity, and equality of all people. Every person is entitled to live without fear of persecution, harassment, or discrimination, For centuries. there has been recognition within Judaism and Jewish movements of a diverse spectrum of sex and gender identities. Across Jewish legal codes and rabbinic commentary, there are hundreds of references to at least six different genders. Many of our texts affirm the existence of transgender, intersex, and genderfluid individuals and acknowledge that gender may change after birth. Multiple federal courts have ruled that federal sex discrimination laws - including Title VII, Title IX, the Fair Housing Act, Equal Credit Opportunity Act, and Section 1557 of the Affordable Care Act – also prohibit discrimination against transgender people. Children benefit from sports both in school and outside of school in a whole plethora of ways, As a former figure skating coach, I saw directly how my students' sports activities improved their work ethic, helped them deal with frustration and emotional regulation, gave them encouragement to perform better in school, and helped them build social relationships with both peers and with people outside their peer cohort. There is also significant research into how team sports help children learn to work in groups and how sports in general reduce all sorts of social problems among school age children. Children in sports are less likely to try drugs or alcohol, less likely to drop out of school before graduation, and are less likely to get in trouble with police or have other behavioral difficulties.All of these benefits should be as available to trans children as they are to children who identify with the gender they were assigned at birth. The concerns about strength or other advantages that trans girls might have in sports are completely misplaced in youth sports. Prepubescent children have no gender disparity in sports to begin with. Those trans children who start hormone blockers before the age of 16 also have no gender based advantage in sports. The only time that a gender based advantage *might* arise is if a child has gone through a complete male puberty before starting hormone blockers or estrogen. Even in those cases, the supposed advantage is within the variance of ability within female athletes who were assigned female at birth once the youth has been on hormones for 1 year. In the case of trans boys, there is no gender advantage for the trans athlete at all. This concern over sports advantage is so completely outweighed by the injustice of keeping any child out of sports which will provide them with life long benefits that it has no place in the discussion. In my coaching certification training, one of the lessons that was hammered in again and again in regards to working with children is that winning is not the most important factor in youth sports. The most important factors are the lessons that children gain from the experience of participating in those sports. No one is going to change their gender just to win in sports. Even if someone tried to do that, they would stop fairly quickly once they realized the cost to their physical body and their mental health. Boys on hormone blockers and/or estrogen get weaker and slower, they gain fat more easily and it is harder for them to build muscle. This is not something that an athlete intent on winning is going to be alright with. Furthermore, the experience of having a body with hormones that do not align with your internal self identification is extremely distressing. One need only look to the life of the mathematician who broke the Enigma code during World War II. Alan Turing, to see what happens when a man is forced to take emasculating hormones. It leads to depression and suicidality, neither of which are competitive advantages in any sport. Only a real trans girl will be happy and well adjusted while undergoing such a gender transition, so the danger of boys using gender transition to win at sports is completely unfounded.

If we only welcome trans children when their "trans-ness" is a disadvantage, then we don't welcome them at all. To exclude them is unkind, and unloving, not to mention unprecedented in our over-all approach to body differences in sports.

I am Katherine Sasser and I live in Columbia. MO. I am a career-long educator, currently serving as a school board member, but I come to you today as a mom. I oppose HB2461. I want to tell you a story about the day my oldest daughter decided to walk away from team sports. She was only 7 years old, 3 vears into her blooming youth soccer career, Soccer Saturdays were her favorite day. She was the selfproclaimed leading goal scorer (and the only person keeping track), and she was her teammates' biggest cheerleader. She completely lit up when she was on the field with her friends. She was in her element, with her people. That changed in the fall of 2018. My daughter arrived at the soccer fields on a bright sunny Saturday for the first day of the new season. We walked up to meet her new coach and new team, her beaming eyes were already searching for faces of familiar friends. As her eyes registered her teammates in the distance, she saw something that made her heart drop: a group of boys wearing the same uniform she wore. I watched in horror as she visibly folded up inside of herself. To this point, her teams had been co-ed, as we expected this one to be. This year, the soccer club changed from co-ed to girls and boys teams, and this was the first we learned of it. In doing so, the club placed my transgender daughter, who is legally female, on the boys team. My daughter was shaken and confused. "Mom, why are there only boys on my team? Why aren't there girls like me? Where are my friends?" We paused. I felt my chest burn and my mind spin a thousand directions as I searched for a way to make her feel safe and known at that moment. I knelt down to meet my daughter in the eyes and said, "I know this isn't what we expected, and I know you love soccer. What would you like to do right now?" She looked over at the team, then looked back at me with tearful eyes and a settled certainty, then said, "Let's just go home Mom. I know I don't belong here." And so we left. Just two weeks ago, my daughter came to me and shared she wanted to try youth girls rec soccer again. I'm terrified. She's determined. We all care about protecting women and girls. We all want our daughters to experience the joy and struggle of belonging to a team -- to learn community building, leadership skills and many other benefits of team sports. We want to celebrate with them in their wins and hold them in the pains of defeat. I worry my child won't get to experience this. My daughter simply wanted to show up as herself to participate in something she enjoyed with a community she loved. She was robbed of that opportunity when she was treated differently.. This youth sports ban will formalize this practice into law. Will you take away the same opportunity from trans youth across our state? I urge you to protect our youth and vote against HB2461. Thank you.

At the root, it's about erasing and excluding transgender people from participation in all aspects of public life. Excluding transgender children from normal school activities fuels a culture of bias that puts kids in danger, and failing to support transgender student athletes only perpetuates a culture of bias. I could not imagine that being taken away from me simply for being my authentic self. All students deserve to be their authentic selves. All students deserve the opportunity to be part of the full educational experience including the freedom to play sports with friends. As Executive Director at PROMO, I will work towards a future where all Missourians thrive, no matter our genders, races, or ages. I invite the representatives and senators supporting this legislation to be leaders for all Missourians.

I have over 10 years of training and clinical experience in transgender health that give me a deep understanding of trans people. I put my heart into my work but ultimately my heart belongs to my two children, including my transgender son. I have been to testify year after year to defend his right to use the bathroom at school and defend his right to play sports with his peers at school. I imagine you know what it feels like to love a child so deeply that you pledge to protect and nourish them with all of your being. This is the way I love my kids too. My child is part of an incredible group of young men who share a love of running. He is a proud kid with a coach who feels lucky to have him and a team full of athletes who welcome him. Everyone is better for it, fair and square. Although I believe it is about something much deeper and more sinister, let's imagine this bill was introduced in the name of fairness. This is chocked full of issues, let me run us through just a few...Issue 1: The idea that trans athletes are a threat to the integrity of sports is starkly revealed as a falsehood by the lack of any dominance, at any level, by athletes who are trans. Issue 2: MSHSA already has a policy and procedure in place. Trans girls must have their testosterone suppressed for a year, removing any possible hormonal advantage. Where are the victims of this current practice? This bill makes certain victims where there are currently none. Issue 3:How do you possibly reconcile the fact that this bill mandates transboys onto girls' teams? Boys who are on testosterone, boys who are visibly boys despite birth certificates that say they are girls, boys who are recognized as boys all day at school are now competing on and against your girls' teams. Isn't this the very "problem" you are seeking to legislate away? This bill is problematic. This bill being voted on by legislators who do not accept or understand trans youth is deeply problematic. You know what's not problematic? Trans athletes continuing to participate on teams that align with their gender. If you still believe you have a right or duty to move this bill along, it is your responsibility to educate yourselves and those of us with years of professional and lived experiences will help you. Moving forward without such diligence will harm many MO children and is a blatant lapse of your duty as an elected official.

With these conversations, I dived deep into my own personal experiences to you all in regards of my transition, my childhood, and even some areas that I am still figuring out. For me, hearing the stories of school age children who were able to showcase their authenticity to not only their families but their classmates and educators, showed me the type of courage that I was still fighting against in my own life. Living in rural Missouri (Palmyra), I had to hide who I truly was due to the pressures from my peers, outside environments, etc. and that alone almost led me to attempts on my own demise. When I think about what life would have been if I showcased my authenticity during my prime years, I would be reminded of an alternative life that would not have led me to that very moment two years ago in the Education Committee here in the Missouri State Senate and my ultimate decision to live my life freely and unapologetically authentic. House Bills 2197, 2461, and 2734 will ultimately prohibit the ability for students to showcase their authenticity while sharing their talents with their peers. Transgender students are some of the most resilient individuals I know, and most of them got that from not only their families but their peers as well. Students regardless of their gender identity should have that freedom of expression without the fear of being bullied due to them showcasing that authenticity. To some, being able to showcase their talents is the only avenue to their true happiness as well as them being able to showcase their authenticity. For me, I see it as showing courage to fight against intolerance and bigotry and show that they are still standing in their truth and show to others that it is okay to show that pride within yourself, and HB's 2197, 2461, and 2734 will stand in the way for countless individuals whether they reside in St. Louis City, Saline County, or even in my hometown of Palmyra. In closing, when you think of the children who would be affected by this legislation, for a moment think of what you would do as a parent if your child showed happiness by showing their authenticity and then having to refute that authenticity, how much pain and anguish they would go through. At the end this is more than being able to participate, this is something that could drastically change how students who are transgender see the world and possibly turn to other mechanisms to suppress their true selves. My name is Dr. Kerri Schafer and I live in Columbia. MO. I am a licensed psychologist, working with college students at the MU Counseling Center and on the board of The Center Project, Mid-Missouri's first and only LGBTQ community center. I oppose HB 2461. This line of legislation clearly exists because we as a community understand the benefits of participating in team sports. I was painfully shy as a child and teenager and being part of the tennis team in high school was a huge source of selfesteem for me. On the tennis court I felt happy, free, and un-self-conscious. I was secure in my sense of belonging with my team. I learned how to handle disappointment and failure, and how to support and uplift others. Many of you or your children probably have similar stories about the positive impact of being part of something - a team, an organization, a community. There are a lot of misconceptions about the impact of transgender girls participating on girls' sports teams. Some of these arguments may seem reasonable at first glance. However, the reality is that transgender athletes are not much different than the other girls they participate with - very few of them become elite athletes. They participate in sports for the same reasons as any student: to have fun, challenge themselves, and experience the sense of belonging that comes with being part of a team. There is no evidence that transgender girls are bigger, stronger, or faster than other girls, and they should not be punished for this incorrect assumption. In fact, when a non-transgender girl is exceptionally tall or strong, we celebrate that and encourage participation in sports - "Wow, have you thought about playing volleyball?!"Sense of belonging is a huge benefit of team sports. Everyone wants to feel part of something - a family, a group of friends, a faith community, a team. Unfortunately, transgender kids are often excluded from this sense of belonging. We know that trans kids are already at high risk of poor treatment and exclusion from all sides. We also know that excluding transgender students from teams that align with their gender identity really means excluding them from sports altogether. I want our state to do better than this kind of discrimination. We can continue to leave policies up to our state high school activities association (which currently allows transgender students to play on the team that aligns with their gender identity) and prevent government overreach. Transgender students deserve our respect and protection. Every single day, these students are choosing to live their lives with integrity, despite the risks. We should be celebrating them and giving them opportunities to thrive, not excluding them. Please vote against HB 2461. Thank you very much for your time today.

Testimony in opposition to HB 2197, HB2461, HB2734Advocates of Planned Parenthood of the St. Louis Region and Southwest Missouri opposes HB 2197, HB2461 & HB 2743's transgender youth athlete bans.Transgender kids should be treated with dignity and respect, just like everyone else, but HB 2197/2734/2461 singles them out for discrimination by banning them from participating in sports. Kids learn a lot of important life lessons in sports: leadership, confidence, self-respect, how to win, how to lose, and what it means to be part of a team — all young people, including transgender young people, deserve this opportunity. The additional study required by HB2461 is unnecessary as we know trans kids in Missouri should be able to be part of a team and play the sport they love as their authentic selves, just like any other young student. The benefits—physiological, social, and emotional—of participating in school sports teams and athletics are wide-ranging. In addition to physiological benefits such as lower rates of obesity, research has found that high school and college studentathletes may be at lower risk for anxiety and depression, suicide attempts, and tobacco and illegal drug use. Sports participation has also been associated with increased self-esteem and selfconfidence, improved academic performance, stronger feelings of school connectedness and schoolbased social support, and broader social capital and community connectedness. Sports participation can also help increase opportunity for vulnerable school-age youth. For those who have experienced adverse childhood events-including poverty, disruption in family structure or family deaths, or learning or behavioral problems—sports participation can be a source of resilience and empowerment, protecting against short- and long-term negative impacts to mental health and well-being. These benefits can have lifelong effects. There is evidence that participating in high school or collegiate athletics is associated with higher wages and better jobs-meaning, for example, more-senior positions or more benefits offered alongside compensation. There are more than a dozen states with policies that allow transgender kids to participate in sports— and they're working. What we can't have is a policy that starts off by singling out and isolating transgender youth so they aren't allowed to play sports with the other kids in their school. Each one of us has a different biological make-up and this biological variance is part of the human experience. Legislating on the basis of something that scientists tell us is arbitrary and indeterminate isn't just baseless - it's dangerous. Do we really want the state to be mandating invasive physical inspections of female students in order for them to participate in sports? No, this is not an appropriate place to use the power of state government to control issues that are personal. Transgender kids want the opportunity to play sports for the same reason other kids do: to be a part of a team where they feel like they belong. We shouldn't discriminate against kids and ban them from playing because they're transgender. Instead of targeting trans students with discriminatory measures like HB 2197/2734/2461, we encourage the legislature to focus

on measures that protect all kids, including trans kids.

I am writing this testimony to the members of the House General Law Committee, I am Rebecca Biermann (she/her) and I reside in St. Louis city with my wife and two children. I want to state that I strongly oppose HB 2734, HB 2197 and HB 2461. These bills are very personal to me and my family. I am now an adult, but I grew up in a small town in Missouri. When I was younger, I did most things kids my age were doing. We played soccer, and basketball, and softball. We had sleepovers, and slumber parties and campouts. I participated in Girl Scouts, but never made it past being a brownie. You see, it was at about this time in my life when I realized I was different. I looked around at my friends and never saw myself to be like them, but I didn't know why. I didn't know why I didn't enjoy dresses, or pink, or bows, I just didn't. My parents weren't sure what to do about this, so they just chalked it up to me being a "tomboy." I struggled. My mental health struggled, I didn't like the way I felt about myself, and I tried my best to be the girl everyone wanted me to be. The truth is, I didn't have the support, or the knowledge, or the understanding to be anything else. It wasn't in my vocabulary to know if maybe I was non-binary, or transgender. It was never an option for me and so I adapted. It has taken years and years of therapy for me to understand who I am in this world. I often think, maybe if I had the words, and the knowledge back then, I would be a different person today. A much less damaged person. I vividly remember an incident that happened to me on the soccer field when I was 6 or 7 years old. We were in the middle of the game a few minutes before half time, and I had just scored my third goal of the game. All the sudden the game stopped, and I remember the referee going over to my coaches and talking with them on the sidelines. I was then asked to come over to where they were speaking. The referee asked me if I was a boy or a girl. I said girl. How humiliating. I had short hair and I was good at soccer, so they questioned my sex, in front of everyone. I am now 36 years old, and this still haunts me. It was April 17, 2021, my family and I were having a typical Saturday morning, when our daughter let us know who she truly was. She said I am a girl. Can you tell my teachers, and can I use the girls bathroom? That was it. There were no questions from us, no pushing her to try to not identify with her gender, no shaming, just love. We surrounded her with love. Her mother and I cried. A lot. Because we know how hard this world can be, especially to those who do not identify with their sex assigned at birth. We know how hateful and spiteful people can be. I don't know if she will want to play sports, but if she does. I hope she can play on the team where she feels she belongs. Let the kids play. Without fear of being outed, shamed, or questioned. Just let them play the games they enjoy. If I would have been told I had to leave the soccer field because no one knew if I was a boy or a girl, it would have destroyed me. This is not about winning and losing, this is about creating a world where kids who are trans can feel included and loved. After all, isn't being alive more important than scoring goals, scoring a touchdown, or hitting a jump shot? I think so, and I was an athlete through and through. I am asking you, to think about the lives you will save and the people you will touch by opposing HB. 2734, HB 2197 and HB

 ${\bf 2461}$. It's time we do better Missouri. Thank you to the committee for your time.

My name is Samati Nivomchai. I am a licensed clinical social worker with experience working with LGBTQ people and youth and am a resident of Missouri. This bill is a textbook case of government overreach and intrusion, and is part of an aggressive attack on transgender Missourians, specifically, transgender youth of Missouri, some of the most vulnerable amongst us. Bills like this seek to single out transgender youth for increased bullying and harassment by banning them from playing sports they love. Playing sports is a priceless part of a student's physical, social, and emotional well-being. Athletics provides students critical opportunities for leadership, self-discipline, teamwork, celebrating success, and learning from failure, as well as a sense of belonging and being a part of a team. This is true of all athletes, including if they are transgender. High school is hard enough for teens, and it's especially hard for transgender students who often face bullying, harassment and mistreatment because of their gender identity. They should never be singled out for discrimination. Schools across the state and across the country know that transgender students want what any other student wants: to be treated with dignity and respect. Schools shouldn't treat a student who is a transgender girl as a girl between during the school day and then treat her like a boy when practice starts. It is deeply painful to the student and disrupts the school policy of treating all students fairly. Excluding transgender athletes from participation in teams that align with their gender identity, often results in excluding them from sports altogether. Being excluded from sports all together makes it more challenging for transgender students to succeed given the benefits athletics brings to students' lives. Our laws should protect, not target transgender youth. Inclusion isn't new: here are over twenty-five states that have athletic inclusion policies allowing transgender youth to compete along side their peers. The International Olympic Committee, the National Collegiate Athletic Association, dozens of high school athletic associations, and specific sports federations and leagues all have developed their own effective, and inclusive policy allowing transgender athletes to participate equally and fairly. The IOC and NCAA have had policies for over a decade and have never encountered a single issue. Alternately, organizations and associations (like University Interscholastic League — Texas' version of MSHSAA) with exclusionary policies similar to those suggested in HB 2197, HB 2461, HB 2734 have created more problems and issues for all athletes than inclusive policies. The sheer financial impact of this bill could also seriously ieopardize Missouri's growing economy. Contrary to the fiscal note on this bill, there is a high possibility that athletic organizations will refuse to invest in Missouri, just like we saw with the NCAA pulling out of North Carolina after their legislature passed a regressive antitransgender bathroom law leaving them with a loss of over \$600 million according to Forbes. Time and again athletic organizations have shown their value through inclusion, and this bill does just the opposite, threatening the athletic investments in the state we call home. This is really about whether or not ALL LGBT people, including transgender students, should be treated fairly in all areas of life just because of who we are. We live in a state where I, because I am a bisexual man, can be fired from work,

denied a place to live, or denied service at a restaurant, bar, movie theater or doctor's office, and have no legal recourse. This bill, and legislation like it, would put the civil liberties of a minority up to a vote of the majority, and amend our constitution. We need to do what's right now by not allowing this amendment to be up for public vote. 76% of LGBTQ youth felt that the recent political climate impacted their mental health or sense of self. The effects of a state wide ballot initiative on Missouri's transgender youth will be harmful. I strongly urge the committee to vote against this legislation. HB 2461 is an assault on the well-being of innocent children. That is enough reason to oppose it, but here I shall point out that its definition of sex is naive and simplistic. Presumably it means that baby with a Y chromosome is male. On the other hand, maleness is not conferred by the chromosome but by the SRY gene, which is usually on the Y chromosome but sometimes shows up elsewhere. What then? Worse yet: some people are chromosomally and genetically male but grow up as girls. They have female genitalia, but don't have ovaries, Fallopian tubes, or uteruses. They generally are raised as girls, and identify as girls. As they grow up they develop a typically female body form, with breasts but not beards. They may not even know anything is out of the ordinary until they discover that they can't become pregnant. This bill would kick them out of women's sports and send them to the football coach. Even children know what sex they are better than legislators in Jefferson City who will never know their names or faces. Trust them.

One of the reasons for creating a category of women's sports that is separate from men's sports is to prevent injury. Another is to allow for greater matching of biological difference in physique/physiology, only one of which is gender. As males and females develop, they have measurable and noticeable differences in physique/physiology. This includes but is not limited to the following: the manner in which they carry their weight, their center of gravity, breath capacity, chest cavity, internal organ placement, foot size, hand size, weight, bone structure, height, cranium shape/size, muscle and skeletal development, cardio vascular volume, heart size and volume, bone density, and other physiological differences which are far too numerous to document. These differences are discernible by scientists even after death. These physiological differences are unaffected by surgery and/or hormones. Apart from gender, it is these multitude of physiological differences between biological males and females that were and are the primary reason for creating a category of women's sports that is separate and distinct from men's sports in the first place. Allowing players of such different physique/physiology to actively complete and/or engage in highly physical contact sports could significantly increase potential injury to players. Such injuries could be severe and permanent, particularly in high contact sports. Beyond physical injury, this practice could result in mental and emotional harm and anguish to players (i.e. reduced self esteem, withdrawal, anxiety, etc.) due to a mismatch in physiology/physique which cannot be altered even with the most rigorous practice, mental focus, and determination on the part of biological females. During evaluation of this topic, the committee should consider ALL biological factors - some of which are listed here - when determining whether it is appropriate for biological males to compete in women's sports, as these physiological differences cannot be altered via hormones and surgery. They comprise the entirety of a person's physique/physiology and are not limited to gender. The well-being and rights of biological females include their ability to compete without fear of severe injury, their ability to have confidence in the spirit of fair competition, the opportunity to develop self-confidence in their own ability, and the importance of maintaining their mental and emotional well-being.
