Dear Chairman Shaul and Members of the Election Committee: The Freedom Principle STL submits this testimony in support of HJR 131. The right to vote is essential to our American democracy. For almost 250 years, Americans have gone to the voting booth to choose one candidate for a specific office. HJR 131 protects the one-person-one-vote standard and will prevent the efforts of dark money funded groups like Better Elections MO from implementing Rank Choice Voting in Missouri.Groups like Better Elections MO is promoting Rank Choice Voting as a change to our current election process and give voters more options and decrease partisan extremism. It sounds good, but it is a fairy tale. Rank Choice Voting is literally RANK! Rank Choice Voting doesn't eliminate negative campaigns, but it does disenfranchise voters. Rank Choice Voting creates ballot exhaustion. Rank Choice Voting takes away a voter's one-person-one-vote and instead forces them to rank all candidates from favorite to least favorite. If no candidate gets more than 50% of votes based on voters' first choice, an "instant runoff" takes place. This forces voters to strategize through hypothetical third, fourth, or fifth rounds of elimination rather than focusing on their first choice among top candidates. Our election process was shaken to its core in 2020. The right to vote and the right to have that vote counted is essential to election integrity. Missouri residents must have confidence in the electoral systems, processes, and results. HJR 131 protects the integrity of our elections, and we urge the Committee to approve. The Freedom Principle STL is a Pro-America, Pro-St. Louis Region, Pro-Capitalism and Pro-Individual Liberty, membership-based organization working to engage citizens who have become disenfranchised with the current policies enacted by our progressive government leaders.

Missouri Voter Protection Coalition opposes HJR 131. This is a proposed constitutional amendment to modify Art. VIII of the Missouri constitution to clarify that: (i) only US citizens are allowed to vote (which is already the case), (ii) that voters may only cast a single vote for each candidate or issue; and (iii) that the political party candidate receiving the most votes in a primary will be the only candidate for that party in the general election. MOVPC opposes this resolution on grounds that it would needlessly further restrict voter participation in primary elections, and appears designed to counter the growing movement towards greater openness and less partisanship in primary elections. We should be looking at models that further open participation, not constrict it. House Joint Resolution No. 131 seeks to stifle Missourians' voice in politics by preemptively dictating what they can say with their vote. Therefore, we respectfully ask you to oppose HJR 131. The bill language states that "voters cast a single vote for each office or issue" and that a "winner of any political party primary election be the only candidate for that political party on the ballot." This is clearly a legislative maneuver designed to prevent the future implementation of other voting conventions, such as rankedchoice voting, which would allow the top candidates, regardless of political affiliation, to appear on the ballot. Trying to put in place rules that would prevent rank-choice voting or disregard for political affiliation is an example of the legislature trying to exert undue influence on the votes, and therefore voice, of the people of Missouri. Once again, Missouri Coalition for the Environment respectfully asks you to vote "no" on HJR 131 in order to preserve the right of Missourians to voice their opinions by voting.
