11 "No funds shall be expended in furtherance of the 75th percentile of the current child care market
12 for provider rates, as determined from the 2021-2022 child care market rate survey, and no funds
13 shall be expended in furtherance of any rate enhancement greater than the rate in effect on January
14 1, 2023, and no funds shall be expended in furtherance of any benefit greater than that provided for
15 by the applicable traditional or transitional child care subsidy income eligibility threshold.";

17 Further amend said bill, said page, Section 2.510, by deleting Line 4 through and including Line 9
18 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
19 "No funds shall be expended in furtherance of the 75th percentile of the current child care market
20 for provider rates, as determined from the 2021-2022 child care market rate survey, and no funds
21 shall be expended in furtherance of any rate enhancement greater than the rate in effect on January
22 1, 2023, and no funds shall be expended in furtherance of any benefit greater than that provided for
23 by the applicable traditional or transitional child care subsidy income eligibility threshold.";
