8 learning platform for middle school and high school students,  
9 provided the platform aligns to Missouri science standards through  
10 an engaging narrative-driven curriculum and allows students to make  
11 strategic choices as they apply Missouri standards to real world  
12 technologies inside a safe simulated environment; and highlights  
13 science, technology, engineering, and mathematics and career  
14 and technical education pathways in Missouri to increase  
15 students’ interest in pursuing a chemistry-related career  
16 From General Revenue Fund.....\$2,000,000”;

18 Further amend said bill, Page 6, Section 2.080, Line 4, by inserting immediately thereafter the  
19 following:

21 “Section 2.082. To the Department of Elementary and Secondary  
22 Education  
23 Funds are to be transferred out of the State Treasury to the  
24 Urban Flight and Rural Needs Scholarship Program Fund  
25 From Lottery Proceeds Fund.....\$800,000  
26  
27 Section 2.083. To the Department of Elementary and Secondary  
28 Education  
29 For the Urban Flight and Rural Needs Scholarship Program  
30 From Urban Flight and Rural Needs Scholarship Program Fund.....\$800,000”;

32 Further amend said bill, said page, Section 2.090, Line 4, by inserting after the word “Fund” the  
33 following: “(including \$100,000 one-time)”;

35 Further amend said bill, said page, said section, said line, by deleting “500,000” and inserting  
36 “850,000”;

Further amend said bill, said page, said section, said line, by deleting “1,860,000” and inserting “2,560,000”;

Further amend said bill, Page 26, Section 2.425, Line 5, by deleting “32,000” and inserting “122,000”;

Further amend House Bill No. 3, Page 6, Section 3.100, Line 6, by inserting immediately thereafter the following:

“Section 3.103. To the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development  
For the Missouri Returning Heroes Program, provided that reimbursement paid to each institution of higher education shall not exceed fifty percent (50%) of the waived tuition reported by said institution of higher education for the previous academic year, and further provided that funding shall be allocated to each institution of higher education proportionally to the amount of waived tuition reported for the previous academic year  
From General Revenue Fund ..... \$400,000  
From Lottery Proceeds Fund.....200,000”;

Further amend said bill, Page 8, Section 3.130, Line 13 by inserting immediately thereafter the following:

“For the purpose of funding a social work pilot program located in a city with more than seventy-one thousand but fewer than seventy-nine thousand inhabitants, provided that program eligibility is limited to Missouri residents with a minimum of sixty hours toward an approved bachelors program leading to a degree in social work or a minimum of six hours towards an approved masters of social work; and further provided grants shall be awarded up to the cost of coursework tuition and general fees; and further provided no more than five percent of this subsection can be used to market the grant program and no more than ten percent of this subsection can be used to offset institutional costs for clinical placement and site visits  
From General Revenue Fund ..... \$300,000”;

Further amend said bill by adjusting section and bill totals accordingly.
