AMEND House Amendment No. \_\_\_\_ to Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill Nos. 189, 36 & 37, Page 30, Line 24, by deleting said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

""565.087. 1. As used in this section, "target" means knowingly causing serious physical injury to any person, or attempting to do so, because of the actual or perceived status of the person as a law enforcement officer, whether on duty or off duty.

2. Any person who intentionally targets a law enforcement officer shall be guilty of a class A felony and, notwithstanding any other provision of law, shall not be eligible for:

(1) Suspended imposition of sentence or suspended execution of sentence; or

(2) Parole or conditional release until such person has served a minimum of:

(a) Ten years of imprisonment or eighty-five percent of the person's sentence, whichever is greater, for targeting, after deliberation upon the matter; or

(b) Five years of imprisonment or eighty-five percent of the person's sentence, whichever is greater, for attempted targeting involving a deadly weapon, after deliberation upon the matter.
