17 ~~person is affiliated with a public or private elementary or secondary school in an official capacity and,~~
18 ~~knowing of its content and character, such person provides, assigns, supplies, distributes, loans, or coerces~~
19 ~~acceptance of or the approval of the providing of explicit sexual material to a student or possesses with the~~
20 ~~purpose of providing, assigning, supplying, distributing, loaning, or coercing acceptance of or the approval of~~
21 ~~the providing of explicit sexual material to a student.~~

22 ~~2. The offense of providing explicit sexual material to a student is a class A misdemeanor.~~

23 ~~3. As used in this section, the following terms shall mean:~~

24 ~~(1) "Explicit sexual material", any pictorial, three-dimensional, or visual depiction, including any~~
25 ~~photography, film, video, picture, or computer-generated image, showing human masturbation, deviate sexual~~
26 ~~intercourse as defined in section 566.010, sexual intercourse, direct physical stimulation of genitals,~~
27 ~~sadomasochistic abuse, or emphasizing the depiction of postpubertal human genitals; provided, however, that~~
28 ~~works of art, when taken as a whole, that have serious artistic significance, or works of anthropological~~
29 ~~significance, or materials used in science courses, including but not limited to materials used in biology,~~
30 ~~anatomy, physiology, and sexual education classes shall not be deemed to be within the foregoing definition;~~

31 ~~(2) "Person affiliated with a public or private elementary or secondary school in an official capacity",~~
32 ~~an administrator, teacher, librarian, media center personnel, substitute teacher, teacher's assistant, student~~
33 ~~teacher, law enforcement officer, school board member, school bus driver, guidance counselor, coach, guest~~
34 ~~lecturer, guest speaker, or other nonschool employee who is invited to present information to students by a~~
35 ~~teacher, administrator, or other school employee. Such term shall not include a student enrolled in the~~
36 ~~elementary or secondary school.]; and~~
