1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 186, Page 3, Section 56.601, Line 50, by
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

3
4 "115.133. 1. Except as provided in subsection 2 of this section, any citizen of the United
5 States who is a resident of the state of Missouri and seventeen years and six months of age or older
6 shall be entitled to register and to vote in any election which is held on or after his eighteenth
7 birthday.

8 2. No person who is adjudged incapacitated shall be entitled to register or vote. No person
9 shall be entitled to vote:

10 (1) While confined [~~under a sentence of imprisonment;~~

11 (~~2) While on probation or parole~~] after conviction of a felony[~~;- until finally discharged from~~
12 ~~such probation or parole~~]; or

13 [~~(3)~~] (2) After conviction of a felony or misdemeanor connected with the right of suffrage.

14 3. Except as provided in federal law or federal elections and in section 115.277, no person
15 shall be entitled to vote if the person has not registered to vote in the jurisdiction of his or her
16 residence prior to the deadline to register to vote."; and

18 Further amend said bill, Page 11, Section 558.043, Line 16, by inserting after all of said section and
19 line the following:

21 "561.026. Notwithstanding any other provision of law except for section 610.140, a person
22 who is convicted:

23 (1) Of [~~any offense~~] a felony shall be disqualified from registering and voting in any
24 election under the laws of this state while confined [~~under a sentence of imprisonment~~];

25 (2) Of a felony or misdemeanor connected with the exercise of the right of suffrage shall be
26 forever disqualified from registering and voting;

27 (3) Of any felony shall be forever disqualified from serving as a juror."; and

29 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
30 accordingly.
