AMEND House Bill No. 282, Page 10, Section 571.030, Line 186, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:
"571.060. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful transfer of weapons if he or she:
(1) Knowingly sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers a firearm or ammunition for a
firearm to any person who, under the provisions of section 571.070, is not lawfully entitled to
possess such;
(2) Knowingly sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers a blackjack to a person less than
eighteen years old without the consent of the child's custodial parent or guardian, or recklessly, as
defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers any firearm to a person less
than eighteen years old without the consent of the child's custodial parent or guardian; provided, that
this does not prohibit the delivery of such weapons to any peace officer or member of the United
States Armed Forces or National Guard while performing his or her official duty; [or]
(3) Recklessly, as defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers a
firearm or ammunition for a firearm to a person who is intoxicated; or
(4) Knowingly sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers an AR-15 rifle to any person,
provided that this does not prohibit the delivery of such firearm to any peace officer or member of
the United States Armed Forces or National Guard while performing his or her official duty.
2. A person commits the offense of unlawful transfer of weapons if he or she knowingly
buys or receives an AR-15 rifle, provided that this does not prohibit the acceptance of such firearm
by any peace officer or member of the United States Armed Forces or National Guard while
performing his or her official duty.
3. For purposes of this section, an "AR-15 rifle" means any repeating rifle whose action
mechanism automatically loads ammunition into the chamber and prepares it for subsequent firing
but requires a shooter to manually discharge each shot.
<u>4.</u> Unlawful transfer of weapons under subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section is a
class E felony; unlawful transfer of weapons under [subdivisions] subdivision (2) [and], (3), or (4)
of subsection 1 of this section or under subsection 2 of this section is a class A misdemeanor."; and
Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
