1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 28, Page 1, Section 43.253, Line 13, by inserting after all of said section
2 and line the following:

4 "195.780. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

5 (1) "Contractor", a person who spends more than fourteen days per year performing work or
6 service of any kind for a marijuana facility in accordance with a contract with that facility;

7 (2) "Department", the department of health and senior services;

8 (3) "Marijuana facility", an entity licensed or certified by the department of health and
9 senior services to cultivate, manufacture, test, transport, dispense, or conduct research on marijuana
10 or marijuana products;

11 (4) "Owner", an individual who has a financial or voting interest in ten percent or greater of
12 a marijuana facility.

13 2. The department shall require all employees, contractors, owners, and volunteers of
14 marijuana facilities to submit fingerprints to the Missouri state highway patrol for the purpose of
15 conducting a state and federal fingerprint-based criminal background check.

16 3. The department may require that such fingerprint submissions be made as part of a
17 marijuana facility application, a marijuana facility renewal application, and an individual's
18 application for a license or permit authorizing that individual to be an employee, contractor, owner,
19 or volunteer of a marijuana facility.

20 4. Fingerprint cards and any required fees shall be sent to the Missouri state highway
21 patrol's central repository. The fingerprints shall be used for searching the state criminal records
22 repository and shall also be forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a federal criminal
23 records search under section 43.540. The Missouri state highway patrol shall notify the department
24 of any criminal history record information or lack of criminal history record information discovered
25 on the individual. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 610.120 to the contrary, all records
26 related to any criminal history information discovered shall be accessible and available to the
27 department."; and
