1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 253, Page 8, Section 167.1205, Lines 24
2 to 27, by deleting all of the said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3
4 "(4) (a) Districts may restrict the number of students who may transfer to a nonresident
5 district under sections 167.1200 to 167.1230 in each school year to a maximum of three percent of
6 the previous school year's enrollment for the district."; and

7
8 Further amend said bill, Pages 12 to 13, Section 167.1210, Lines 23 to 36, by deleting all of the said
9 lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

10
11 "4. (1) The transferring student or the student's parent is responsible for the transportation
12 of the student to and from the school in the nonresident district where the student is enrolled.

13 (2) A nonresident district may enter into an agreement with the student's parent that the
14 parent may transport the student to an existing bus stop location convenient to the school district if
15 the school district has capacity available on a bus serving that location."; and

16
17 Further amend said bill and section, Page 13, Lines 41 to 47, by deleting all of the said lines and
18 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

20 "6. (1) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 4 of this section to the contrary, any
21 transferring student described in paragraph (b) of this subdivision:

22 a. Shall be offered transportation services provided by the nonresident district; or

23 b. May choose to be reimbursed by the parent public school choice fund established in
24 section 167.1212 for the costs of transportation of the student as provided in this subsection.

25 (b) Paragraph (a) of this subdivision shall apply to a transferring student who transfers to any
26 nonresident district sharing a border with the student's resident district and who:

27 a. Qualifies for free and reduced price meals under federal guidelines; or

28 b. Has transportation as a related service on such student's individualized education program
29 (IEP).

30 (2) The amount of transportation costs eligible for reimbursement to such transferring
31 student or the student's parent under subparagraph b. of paragraph (a) of subdivision (1) of this
32 subsection shall be,"; and

1 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Lines 59 to 61, by deleting the said lines and inserting in
2 lieu thereof the following:

4 "(5) A transferring student who transfers to a nonresident district that does not share a
5 border with the student's resident district shall be eligible for a transfer if the student's parent enters
6 into an agreement with the noncontiguous nonresident district that contains a statement that the
7 parent waives both:

8 (a) Transportation services as described in subparagraph a. of paragraph (a) of subdivision
9 (1) of this subsection including, but not limited to, any transportation as a related service under the
10 student's IEP; and

11 (b) Reimbursement for transportation costs as described in subparagraph b. of paragraph (a)
12 of subdivision (1) of this subsection. "; and

14 Further amend said bill and section, Page 14, Lines 68 to 69, by deleting all of the said lines and
15 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

17 "parent public school choice fund established in section 167.1212 for the actual transportation costs
18 for the student on a quarterly basis and in a manner determined by the department."; and

20 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
21 accordingly.
