1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 70, Page 8, Section 195.100, Line 27, by inserting after all of said section and line  
3 the following:

5 "324.218. 1. The state committee of dietitians may grant a provisional license, for a period  
6 not to exceed twelve months, to an individual who has successfully completed the requirements of  
7 subdivision (1) of subsection 2 of section 324.210 and paid a fee in an amount set by the committee.  
8 An individual holding such provisional license may practice as a dietitian, but any such practice  
9 shall be under the supervision of a dietitian fully licensed in this state.

10 2. Any dietitian who has agreed to supervise a provisional licensee shall hold an  
11 unencumbered license to practice in this state and shall not be an immediate family member of the  
12 provisional licensee.

13 3. All notes written by a provisional licensee documenting services provided in his or her  
14 dietetics practice shall be cosigned by the supervising dietitian.

15 4. A provisional licensee who successfully passes the examination required under  
16 subsection 3 of section 324.210 may request conversion of the provisional license to a full license  
17 after notifying the committee of such passage.

18 5. A provisional license shall terminate upon the earliest of:

19 (1) Receipt of a full license as described in subsection 4 of this section;

20 (2) Failure to pass the examination required under subsection 3 of section 324.210; or

21 (3) Failure to apply for a full license within twelve months of the date the provisional  
22 license was granted."; and

24 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
25 accordingly.
