1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 424, Page 4, Section 136.055, Line 106,
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:
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4 "301.3175. 1. Any vehicle owner may apply for "Back the Blue" license plates for any
5 motor vehicle the person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or a
6 commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of twenty-four thousand pounds gross weight. Upon
7 making a ten dollar contribution to the Missouri Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation, the
8 vehicle owner may apply for the "Back the Blue" plate. If the contribution is made directly to the
9 Missouri Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation, the foundation shall issue the individual making
10 the contribution a receipt, verifying the contribution, that may be used to apply for the "Back the
11 Blue" license plate. If the contribution is made directly to the director of revenue pursuant to
12 section 301.3031, the director shall note the contribution and the owner may then apply for the
13 "Back the Blue" plate. The applicant for such plate shall pay a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the
14 regular registration fees and present any other documentation required by law for each set of "Back
15 the Blue" plates issued pursuant to this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144,
16 no additional fee shall be charged for the personalization of license plates issued pursuant to this
17 section. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the department of revenue shall issue
18 the license plate or plates, as authorized in this section, for nonapportioned vehicles of any
19 classification for which it issues a license plate or plates.

20 2. The "Back the Blue" plate shall bear the emblem of a thin blue line encompassed in black
21 as prescribed by the director of revenue and shall have the words "BACK THE BLUE". Such
22 license plates shall be made with fully reflective material with a common color scheme and design,
23 shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section
24 301.130.

25 [~~2.~~] 3. The director of revenue may promulgate rules and regulations for the administration
26 of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is
27 created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with
28 and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section
29 and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly
30 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are

1 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or
2 adopted after August 28, 2019, shall be invalid and void."; and

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4 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
5 accordingly.
