1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 188, Page 10, Section 285.545, Line 125,
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "290.045. 1. A person who is sixteen years of age or older but under eighteen years of age,
5 enrolled in secondary school as a full-time student, and employed for wages or other remuneration,
6 shall not be permitted or forced or compelled to work after 10:00 p.m. on an evening before a school
7 day when school is in session for the regular school year. The provisions of this section may be
8 waived by the director, on an individualized basis, depending upon the nature of the employment.
9 Such waiver shall be provided in writing to the employer by the director. As used in this section,
10 "director" means the director of the department of labor and industrial relations or his or her
11 authorized representative.

12 2. The provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall not include the following:

13 (a) Any person employed by or working under the direct control of the person's parent or
14 legal guardian;

15 (b) A student who attends a home school as that term is defined under section 167.031; or

16 (c) A full-time student who is eligible to receive credit for work that is performed during the
17 school year based upon criteria established by the secondary school system."; and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
20 accordingly.
