20	2. If the juvenile office believes that there is an immediate safety or flight risk, as provided
21	under subsection 1 of this section, the juvenile officer shall advise the attorney for the child and
22	make a request in writing prior to the commencement of the proceeding for the child to remain
23	restrained during the court proceeding while in the presence of the parties to the proceeding.
24	3. The court shall provide the child's attorney an opportunity to be heard before the court
25	orders the use of restraints. If restraints are ordered, the court shall make findings of fact in support
