1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 222, Page 9, Section
2 182.819, Line 10, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "407.932. 1. Nothing in sections 407.925 to 407.932 shall prohibit local political
5 subdivisions from enacting more stringent ordinances or rules.

6 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, no political subdivision
7 shall deny a license to a qualified applicant for a tobacco products license, an alternative nicotine
8 products license, or a vapor products license if the new license being sought is for the same location
9 that had a license within the previous twenty-four months. Any new licensee shall remain eligible
10 for a tobacco products license, an alternative nicotine products license, or a vapor products license,
11 or the renewal thereof, provided that such licensee is in compliance with applicable rules and laws.
12 The provisions of this subsection shall not be construed to require the political subdivision to
13 increase the total number of tobacco products licenses, alternative nicotine products licenses, or
14 vapor products licenses issued by the political subdivision."; and

16 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
17 accordingly.
