1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 348, 285 & 407, Page 1, Section A, Line  
2 5, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "324.1720. 1. The general assembly hereby occupies and preempts the entire field of  
5 legislation concerning the practice of licensed professions regulated under chapters 331, 332, 334,  
6 335, 336, 337, and 338. A political subdivision of this state is preempted from enacting,  
7 maintaining, or enforcing any order, ordinance, rule, regulation, policy, or other similar measure that  
8 prohibits, restricts, limits, regulates, controls, directs, or interferes with the practice of such licensed  
9 professions.

10 2. Nothing in this section shall preclude or preempt a political subdivision of this state from  
11 exercising its lawful authority to regulate zoning or land use, to enforce a building or fire code  
12 regulation, to impose a tax or license fee for the privilege of carrying on a profession described in  
13 subsection 1 of this section consistent with the laws regulating such taxes or license fees, or to  
14 otherwise regulate for the general health, safety, sanitation, and welfare as long as the order,  
15 ordinance, rule, regulation, policy, or other measure does not interfere with, restrict, or limit the  
16 ability of a lawfully licensed person from engaging in any act or performing any procedure that falls  
17 within the professionally recognized scope of practice of a licensed professional in the practice of a  
18 profession described in subsection 1 of this section."; and

20 Further amend said bill, Page 18, Section 334.1720, Line 11, by inserting after all of said section  
21 and line the following:

23 "340.201. 1. The general assembly hereby occupies and preempts the entire field of  
24 legislation concerning the practice of veterinary medicine regulated under this chapter. A political  
25 subdivision of this state is preempted from enacting, maintaining, or enforcing any order, ordinance,  
26 rule, regulation, policy, or other similar measure that prohibits, restricts, limits, regulates, controls,  
27 directs, or interferes with the practice of veterinary medicine.

28 2. Nothing in this section shall preclude or preempt a political subdivision of this state from  
29 exercising its lawful authority to regulate zoning or land use, to enforce a building or fire code  
30 regulation, to impose a tax or license fee for the privilege of carrying on the profession of veterinary

1 medicine consistent with the laws regulating such taxes or license fees, to require vaccinations and  
2 licensing of animals kept within the boundaries of the political subdivision, to prohibit animal  
3 abuse, or otherwise to regulate for the general health, safety, sanitation, and welfare as long as the  
4 order, ordinance, rule, regulation, policy, or other measure does not interfere with, restrict, or limit  
5 the ability of a lawfully licensed person from engaging in any act or performing any procedure that  
6 falls within the professionally recognized scope of practice of a licensed veterinarian in the practice  
7 of veterinary medicine as defined in section 340.200."; and

9 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
10 accordingly.
